

## SPECIAL SALE DURING GALLERY WEEKEND at joségarcía ,mx

The village of San Gregorio Atlapulco, located in Xochimilco, Mexico City, is in a catastrophic situation. The earthquake that occurred at 1:14 p.m, Tuesday September 19 2017 with a magnitude of 7.1 on the Richter scale, causing various buildings to collapse, damaging others, and making many more uninhabitable in different zones of the city. One of the most affected parts is Xochimilco, particularly San Gregorio, where more than 25 % of apartments are completely destroyed and 65% present severe damage without being totally uninhabitable. Because of this there is a freezing impact on family budgets and on producers dependent on floriculture, agriculture, and tourism.

The solidarity of Mexican people and international specialists helped to save the survivors and is currently establishing the reconstruction of affected areas. In San Gregorio Atlapulco, the products of first necessity for the communities in economic collapse are provided by citizen organizations, like the one we have the honor to support. Nevertheless, the supply of special work tools remains insufficient, leaving the voluntary and public institutions involved in the reconstruction of San Gregorio Atlapulco without primary materials indispensable to continue the social and economic recovery. Currently we are in the period of demolitions of many houses, leaving many people without a place to live.

In the context of a state of emergency after the earthquake of 19th September joségarcía ,mx supports the economic reactivation of San Gregorio Atlapulco and San Luis Tlaxialtemalco, producers of Poinsettias. We kindly ask for your solidarity with our brothers from Xochimilco by buying the products with fair prices, which will help them to reactivate their production and pay the living expenses of their families.
